■ What is the cinecAward?

The cinecAward is an honours prize for outstanding and market-ready achievements and innovations in the fields of motion-picture technology and postproduction. The cinecAwards are awarded at every cinec in Munich.

■ What do the winners of the cinecAward receive?

The cinecAward winners receive an award certificate and a statue of "Bavaria", the symbol of Munich. The awards will be presented during a festive reception by the Bavarian State Ministry for Digital Affairs on the evening of Saturday, 17th September.

■ What are the categories of the cinecAward?

The categories of the cinecAward are:

- Camera Technology/New Digital Capturing Tools
- Lighting Engineering
- Optics
- Camera Support/Grip
- Processing

An eligible "clever idea", which is time-saving or cost-saving or which facilitates the work on the set in other ways, might be awarded with a special prize. The Special Award will be selected from all eligible entries of the five categories received. A separate application is not necessary.

■ Who are eligible nominees?

All exhibitors of cinec 2022 are invited to send their applications.

■ Who decides about the winners?

An international jury of renowned experts will choose the winner in each category. The jury is appointed by the cinecAward committee, consisting of cinec representatives, representatives of the bvK – German Society of Cinematographers, and representatives of Film & TV Kamera. The members of the jury will be announced on the website of cinec.





APPLICATION DEADLINE : August 15th, 2022

■ How do I apply?

After you have registered as exhibitor at cinec 2022, please submit the application documents at the cinec website www.cinec.de/cinecAward // www.cinec.de/cinecaward_e/?lang=en

Please note that the deadline is **August 15th, 2022**.

All applications must be submitted in full by this deadline. The jury will not accept incomplete submissions. Submissions received after this date cannot be considered.

■ What else do I have to do?

All cinecAwards nominees must present their entries to the jury. The jury will meet on September 16th and 17th, 2022 at cinec.

■ Is there a handling fee?

A handling fee of 200€ will be invoiced for each entry.



Guidelines cinecAward 2022

I

The cinecAward is presented by cinec – International Trade Fair for Cine Equipment and Technology – for outstanding achievements and developments in the fields of motion picture technology and postproduction on the occasion of the cinec Expo. The cinecAward comprises a certificate and a statue which is inspired by the Munich symbol "Bavaria".

II

All exhibitors of cinec 2022 are entitled to take part. Only innovations and new developments, which, as a rule, are fully developed and ready for use on the set or in postproduction and were first used in the professional film industry no more than four years before the application deadline for the respective year, are eligible for an award.

III

A duly completed application form for each entry of the competition should be submitted online at www.cinec.de/cinecAward // www.cinec.de/cinecaward_e/?lang=en

IV

A handling fee of 200€ will be invoiced for each entry. Settling the invoice is a prerequisite for the submission to be considered.

V

Entries for awards will be judged by an independent jury whose chairman and other members will be appointed by the cinecAward committee. The jury constitutes a quorum when 50 percent of the members with voting rights are present. The jury's decisions will be made by simple majority. Members of the jury will not take part in discussions and decisions if they or their company are affected by the decision.

VI

The cinecAward 2022 can be presented in the following categories:

1. Camera Technology/New Digital Capturing Tools
2. Lighting Engineering
3. Optics
4. Camera Support/Grip
5. Processing

Special award: An eligible “clever idea”, which is time-saving or cost-saving or which facilitates the work on the set in other ways, might be awarded with a special prize. The Special Award will be selected from all eligible entries (of the four categories) received. A separate application is not permitted.

The jury is not bound to award a prize in each category. Moreover, it can award several prizes in individual categories.

VII

The jury can present the cinec Honorary Award in recognition of special achievements and services to the international motion picture industry.

VIII

Prizes can be awarded only for achievements and developments which are nominated by the jury on the basis of the applications to take part in the competition for the cinecAward. All entries must be presented to the jury for assessment on the occasion of cinec in Munich on the dates announced for the respective trade fair year. The dates scheduled for 2022 are September, 16th and 17th.

IX

The cinecAward will be presented on the evening of September 17th, 2022 during a reception.

X

In case of doubt about the interpretation and application of these guidelines, the cinecAward Jury will decide as seems fair and reasonable. The right to take legal action against the decisions of the jury shall be excluded.

XI

The deadline for applications is August 15th, 2022.
